

Matias Campiani Short Bio

Matias Campiani is the co-founder together with Alex Jiménez-Ness of Welwaze Medical Inc., a U.S. start-up that develops clinically-tested tools to detect, predict and prevent an onset of disease.

The first product to be launched by Welwaze Medical is an affordable at home medical device coupled with a software app, capable of detecting breast abnormalities including breast cancer in the early stages when the chances of survival are the greatest. The product seeks to empower and encourage all women to monitor their breast health throughout their lives. The platform incorporates advanced artificial intelligence to predict the likelihood of developing breast cancer based on individual assessments and risk factors.

Prior to founding Welwaze Medical, Matias was a founding partner of Leadgate Investment Corp., a private equity firm specializing in restructuring companies. In his 10-year tenure with Leadgate, he was actively involved in the management of the companies within a wide scope of industries including auto part suppliers, dairy products, airlines, plywood manufacturing, and information technology.

Previously, Matias co-founded PaceBalde Technologies Europe AG., an early manufacturer and distributor of tablet PCs.

Matias started his career at ALCOA (Aluminum Company of America) holding financial positions in Pittsburgh, London, and Frankfurt.

Matias earned Licentiate (Honors) in Business Administration from the Universidad Católica de Argentina and his MBA from Tepper School of Business, Carnegie Mellon University.

Matias is also an angel investor having invested in several start-up and companies as Cariba A.G, Dayboox, Globant, Commodore International Corporation, Constellate Ltd., Pathelen AG and UK Wind I.
